Marshall Community Park Rules

General

- Hours of operation: dawn through dusk
- No overnight parking or camping
- No smoking, use of smokeless tobacco or electronic cigarettes
- No alcohol
- No disorderly conduct causing unreasonable disruption or annoyance to others

Animals

- All animals must be well-behaved and on a lead at all times
- Animal waste must be disposed of immediately by the animal's caretaker

Prohibited Actions

- Defacing or removing landscaping or property owned by Marshall Park or its caretakers
- Hunting or trapping of animals
- The use or display of weapons
- Operating unauthorized motor vehicles within park grounds
- Littering or dumping household trash in park receptacles
- Open fires are strictly prohibited.

Regulated Use

Prior approval is needed for the following:

- Organizing any assembly, special event or demonstration
- Posting any flag, sign or display
- Selling goods, services, or entertainment

If you would like to use Marshall Park facilities for your special event, please submit a completed Facility Use Form, and have it approved prior to scheduling your event. Permissions are at the sole discretion of the Marshall Park Board or their designated representative. Facility Use Forms are available for download, and completed forms should be sent to Mr. Ted Woods (315) 587-2324.

Marshall Park and its facilities are free and open to the public. The park is funded exclusively by individuals and private charitable organizations.
